

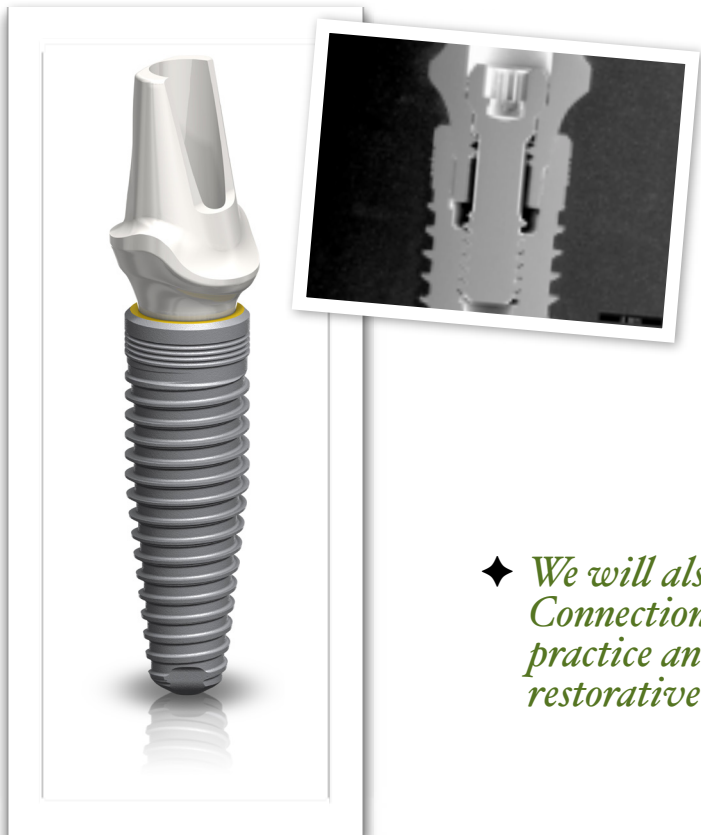
# Treatment Alternatives and Minimally Invasive Approaches for Implant Placement in the Posterior Maxilla
